POLITICALLY EXPOSED PERSONS

IRISH ANTI-MONEY LAUNDERING LEGISLATION REQUIRES UTMOST PANEUROPE DAC TO IDENTIFY IF A NEW OR EXISTING POLICY IS LINKED TO A POLITICALLY EXPOSED PERSON (PEP).

WE ARE REQUIRED TO ESTABLISH IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PARTIES TO AN APPLICATION ARE A PEP, OR ARE CONNECTED TO A PEP:

- > An applicant
- A Policyholder
- A beneficial owner of an applicant or the person funding a contribution paid under a Policy
- > A settlor or trustee of a trust
- A Beneficiary named or nominated under a Policy
- > A Beneficiary of a trust
- Any person having power to direct the activities of an applicant or Policyholder, for example, a person holding power of attorney.

A PEP CAN BE:

- Someone who is currently, or has previously been, entrusted with prominent public functions or responsibilities
- A natural person, a member of their immediate family or a close associate of such a person, or
- › An organisation.
