This is especially so in countries where free education is not available to expats, such as in the United Arab Emirates (UAE). It costs on average **AED 491,348¹ to educate a child in a Dubai school up to university age**, so the sooner you start the more you can save.

It's also important to consider additional costs, many of which are essential and should be planned for in advance.

Please note that costs stated are an average of all curriculum schools and that UK and US curriculum are usually more expensive.

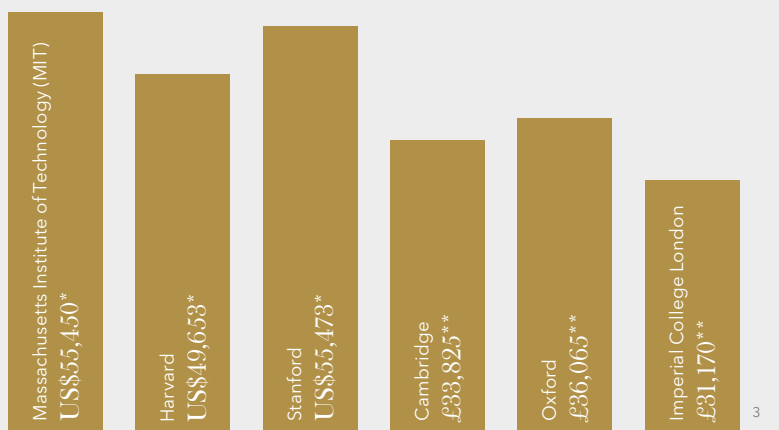

SAVING FOR UNIVERSITY

Of course some of the most costly years spent in education will be while studying at university. Average annual fees vary tremendously around the world, but represent a significant investment wherever your child may wish to study. When putting money aside in advance, it's important to remember that **fees are likely to rise considerably by the time your child is old enough to start.**

Again, these figures do not include additional expenses, which will need to be taken into consideration. The cost of living will vary by country, however students across the UK can expect to pay the equivalent of over **£12,180 per year, or over £15,180 if they are living in London⁴.**

UNIVERSITY ANNUAL FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS, 2020/21³



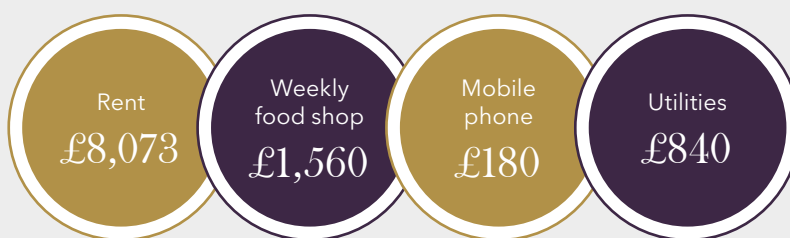
* Fee for all undergraduate programs

THE COST OF STUDYING AT A US UNIVERSITY

The student support organisation College Board estimates that students require an annual budget of US\$52,500 to cover fees, room & board, transport and other living expenses when studying at a private non-profit four-year college. That's a staggering total of US\$210,000 for a four-year course.⁵ **Remember, the cost of living will continue to rise and will be higher once your child is ready to start university.**
